


**Village of Dorchester Board of Trustees Special Meeting  
April 17, 2026**

A Special Meeting of the Village of Dorchester Board of Trustees was held Friday, April 17, 2026, at the Village office, and was called to order at 5:16 p.m. Chairperson Miller advised those present of the Open Meetings Act. Answering Roll Call were board members, Nancy Tellez, Nate Hitchins, Matt Shaw, and Chairperson Roger Miller. Tammie Lang was excused. Also present was Jen Kasl, Clerk-Treasurer. (All motions carried are unanimous "for" unless otherwise noted). Advance notice of the meeting was posted at the Dorchester US Post Office, First State Bank, NE and Village Hall.

The purpose of the meeting was a board workshop to discuss Village investments and financial reports.

Discussion was held on the village's revenue streams, including highway allocation funds, sales tax, TIF, and interest from CDs. Lang arrived at 5:30 p.m. The annual budget and bond payments were reviewed. Discussion was held on replacing the water mains on Lincoln Avenue between 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Streets. Motion by Miller, seconded by Shaw to get a quote from MTZ to replace the water mains. Motion carried.

Motion by Shaw, seconded by Hitchins to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 6:21 p.m. Clerk Kasl will schedule a meeting with Olsson and Northland Securities to go over the assessments and discuss future street projects. Next regular meeting is Monday, May 11, 2026, at 6:30 p.m. at the Farmers Cooperative meeting room.
